Cedarwood Visitation Guidelines

"He gives strength to those who are tired and more power to those who are weak." Isaiah 46:29. If I could offer advice to any family today, it would be to stick by your faith. Know that your God is with you and will take care of you all the way through."

Isaiah 46:29 is a verse that I am using a lot lately as we move past day number 134 of being closed to visitors as I write this. We are humbled that you continue to allow your loved ones to be in our care throughout this pandemic. We are doing our very best to keep them safe but we need your help. We are having a significant amount of trouble with window visits. The following are guidelines that must be followed at all times.

CALL IF YOU ARE COMING FOR A WINDOW VISIT SO THAT WE CAN SCREEN YOU UPON ARRIVAL. (402)729-6100

YOU MUST HAVE AN APPROPRIATELY FITTING FACE MASK ON AT ALL TIMES DURING YOUR VISIT. A SCREEN DOES NOT KEEP OUT GERMS.

YOU MUST MAINTAIN A 6 FOOT DISTANCE FROM YOUR LOVED ONE.

The guidelines stated above are 97.6 percent effective in stopping the spread of Covid-19. PLEASE HELP US KEEP YOUR LOVED ONES SAFE!

As you know we are in Phase three now which has allowed us to have more activities within the facility and communal dining. This has helped boost the spirits of the tenants. We are also allowed to go on Van rides now with appropriate distancing and masks. They have loved this. Just like good old Nebraskans many of them just wanted to see the crops growing. We hope soon that we will be able to start visitations within the facility. For the safety of all our tenants there are very restrictive guidelines that we must follow to open our facility back up to visitors. We are required to have staff available to monitor and supervise all visits to ensure the guidelines are properly followed, at all times, they must be in a designated area, you must be screened before entering the facility, wear a proper fitting facemask and maintain 6 foot social distancing.

Lastly, if you are bringing things for your loved one into the front entry way we ask that you do not walk up to the front door when the tenants are sitting outside enjoying the weather. Please call us at 402-729-6100 and we will be happy to come outside to get your items.


